- ChiNamibia develops, educates, empowers and creates awareness amongst the children and the youth through arts and culture on social issues and preparation for themed events.

Background

- ChiNamibia inspired from CHIPAWO Zimbabwe which was established in 1989.
- CHIPAWO is an Arts Education for Development and empowerment trust that works with children and young people in child development and Arts Education.
- Therefore ChiNamibia was inspired by CHIPAWO to become a like-minded organisation where we teach arts and culture to the children and young people in Namibia.




