Letter of intent in support of Helsingborg city partnership with Bibu (national performing arts biennale for children and young people) and Swedish ASSITEJ in the organising of the ASSITEJ Artistic Gathering (AAG) and Bibu 2022.

Bibu, the national performing arts biennale for children and young people, is Sweden's most important professional performing arts event aimed at, organised with and for, a young audience. The biennale has been organised by Bibu in partnership with Helsingborg city since 2014. Helsingborg city see Bibu as a central part of the city's cultural life and recognise that hosting the biennale has put Helsingborg on the cultural map of Sweden.

Bibu and Swedish ASSITEJ are submitting an joint application to organise an AAG in Helsingborg 2022. Helsingborg city supports their application and will therefore contribute financially to the application process. In addition, Helsingborg city will also contribute financially to the organising of the AAG in Helsingborg 2022.
